"We are committed to empowering and supporting our elders and the community to make them feel independent, strong, and dignified. Among our guests include Ms. Anni Chung, our President and CEO; Mr. Dickson Sum, Self-Help for the Elderly Board Member; Ms. Cindy Kauffman, Deputy Director of Community Services, San Francisco Department of Disability and Aging Services (DAS); Ms. Leah Walton, MPH, RND, Public Health Nutritionist, DAS; District 4 Supervisor Joel Engardio; Mr. Paul Chu and Mr. Richard Choi, S&E Cafe; Mr. Michael Yu, CHAMPSS participant; and Ms. Leny Nair, our CFO.

The CHAMPSS program -- the San Francisco Department of Disability and Aging Services (DAS) in cooperation with Self-Help for the Elderly -- offers a dining opportunity for adults 60 or older and their spouse/partners regardless of age with a dietitianapproved menu, giving the participants the ability to sit down and enjoy a complete meal together.

S&E Cafe is the first restaurant in San Francisco to become a CHAMPSS restaurant a decade ago. At the celebration, Ms. Cindy Kauffman, Deputy Director of Community Services, San Francisco Department of Disability and Aging Services (DAS), along with Supervisor Engardio and Self-Help for the Elderly Board Member Dickson Sum presented Mr. Richard Choi, the owner, a commemorative award, congratulating Mr. Choi for his services to the community and wishing Mr. Choi a happy retirement.

### Press Conference to Warn the Community on Blessing Scams

San Francisco Mayor London N. Breed, District Attorney Brooke Jenkins, and Police Chief Bill Scott held a press conference at Lady Shaw Activity Center in San Francisco Chinatown on February 20, 2024, to raise community awareness on the re-emergence of the Blessings Scam. Police Department officials told seniors to refuse to engage with the scammers if approached, not to hand over any valuables to strangers and to call for help.

Anni Chung, our President and CEO, said that in the past decade, blessing scams have targeted elders beginning a couple of months before Chinese New Year. But it stopped during the pandemic, which she suspected is because perpetrators could not leave China to come to the U.S. due to COVID-19 travel restrictions.

Anni is concerned that the elderly might have forgotten because they haven't encountered this for four years and might fall prey again. The elderly are very trusting, and these blessing scammers would do a lot of harm.

At the press conference, it was announced that Self-Help for the Elderly would collaborate with the San Francisco Police Department to hold similar awareness events at 15 other senior centers.

## 記者會宣傳預防祈福黨騙案

三藩市市長布里德與地檢官謝安宜、警察局長施革一起出席 於二月二十日在安老自助處華埠的邵逸夫爵士夫人康樂中心 召開新聞發佈會,以提高社區對再次出現的「祈福黨」騙局 的認識。

我們的行政總監鍾月娟表示,在過去的十年裏,祈福黨詐騙者從農曆新年前幾個月就開始針對長者。但這種行為在疫情期間停止了,她懷疑這是因為由於新冠疫情旅行限制,詐騙者無法離開中國前往美國。

鍾姑娘亦表示擔心長者可能已經忘記提防祈福黨的騙局了, 因為他們已經四年沒有遇到這種情況了,因此可能會再次成 為受害者。長者們是很信任別人的,這些祈福黨詐騙者的危 害會很大。

在新聞發佈會上亦宣佈,安老自助處將與三藩市警察局合作,在其他十五個長者中心舉辦類似的宣傳預防祈福黨騙案活動。



## Empowering Communities - San Francisco Westside Affordable Housing Resource Fair Set to Inform and Connect

The Housing Element serves as San Francisco's roadmap for meeting the housing needs of all its residents, allowing for the creation of 82,000 housing units, including 46,000 affordable homes for families at very low, low, and moderate incomes over the next 8 years.

In a concerted effort to address the pressing needs of our community, the SF Westside Affordable Housing Resource Fair is gearing up to bring together a diverse array of public and private sectors, city agencies, and community-based nonprofit organizations involved with housing production, financing and operations. Scheduled for March 9, 2024, from 11 am to 4 pm at the San Francisco City and County Fair Building in Golden Gate Park, this event aims to provide vital information on housing, development, affordable housing options, and legal rights for tenants and landlords.

With support from the San Francisco Mayor's Office of Housing & Community Development (MOHCD) and various community partners, Self-Help for the Elderly invited San Francisco residents to the San Francisco Westside Affordable Housing Resource Fair. This comprehensive event was designed to provide valuable information and assistance, empowering individuals with the knowledge necessary to navigate the complex landscape of housing in San Francisco.

#### **Bringing Together Expertise**

This collaborative initiative convened various San Francisco City and County department representatives, sharing the latest updates and insights on housing-related solutions and supports. State and City officials and representatives were present to engage with participants and answer questions.

#### Informative Talks by Industry Specialists

Attendees attended informative talks by experts covering various topics, including housing and development trends, innovative, affordable housing solutions, and legal nuances affecting tenants and landlords. These presentations aimed to empower participants with the most up-to-date information for stable housing solutions.

#### **Connecting Communities with Resources**

The fair hosted 25 exhibitors representing a blend of governmental and community-based resources. From local initiatives to nonprofit organizations, these exhibitors will provide support and information to attendees seeking guidance on housing options and community resources.

"We are pleased to collaborate with SF MOHCD and our partners in bringing this housing resource fair to Westside and the community. The resource fair is free to the public, and we aim to provide more equitable



housing opportunities accessible to San Francisco residents, especially those in need," said Anni Chung, President and CEO of Self-Help for the Elderly.

"We are thrilled to be a part of the community housing resource fair. This event serves as a valuable platform for the City to engage with and support our residents, providing essential affordable housing opportunities and assistance, which is at the heart of MOHCD's mission. We remain committed to playing a proactive role in fostering a more inclusive and supportive housing environment for all, and look forward to our continued collaboration with organizations and community members," said Daniel Adams, Director of San Francisco MOHCD.

Tripp; San Francisco Police Department Chief William Scott; San Francisco City Attorney, David Chiu; Executive Director, San Francisco Department of Disability and Aging Services, Kelly Dearman; San Francisco City Administrator Carmen Chu; San Francisco Assessor-Recorder Joaquin Torres; and Institue on Aging, Elder Abuse Prevention Program, Ali Chiu.

Scams and fraudulent crimes targeting older adults is a major national and local problem, although these crimes are vastly underreported. According to the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI), "scams targeting individuals aged 60 and older caused over \$3.4 billion in losses in 2023—an increase of approximately 11% from the year prior. The average victim of elder fraud lost \$33,915 due to these crimes in

2023." In addition, these crimes often take more than a financial toll, and can result in a loss of independence, reduced quality of life, and poor health outcomes.

Every year, a coalition of organizations including the Department of Disability and Aging Services' Adult Protective Services unit, the San Francisco District Attorney's Office, San Francisco Police Department and community providers, come together to hold trainings and arm older adults with the latest information and how to protect themselves through presentations at community and senior centers throughout the city.
